



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

FACULTY OF SOCIAL ADMINISTRATION, THAMMASAT UNIVERSITY. With official address at 2 Prachan Road, Bangkok 10200, Thailand represented herein by its Dean, **Assoc. Prof.Dr.Decha Sungkawan;**

and

BANDUNG COLLEGE OF SOCIAL WELFARE, with official address at Jl.Ir.H. Juanda No. 367, Bandung 40135, West Java, Indonesia, represented herein by its Chairperson, **Dr.Kanya Eka Santi, MSW;**

Preamble

Following discussions and exchanges of correspondence between FACULTY OF SOCIAL ADMINISTRATION, THAMMASAT UNIVERSITY (herein after "FSA TU") and the Bandung College of Social Welfare, Board of Education and Research on Social Welfare, Republic of Indonesia, at Jl.Ir.H. Juanda No.367 Bandung, West Java, Indonesia (hereinafter "BCSW"), a formal Memorandum of Understanding is made between two institutions. Both FSA TU and BCSW desire to establish certain cooperative programs beneficial to their respective educational institutions, and to promote the development of joint studies, research and training activities, and other educational programs of mutual interest. The first of these exchanges will take place between FSA TU and BCSW in September 2014.

Institutional Agreement

In contemplation of the relationship to be established and for valuable consideration, the parties agree as follow;

1. This agreement replaces all previous agreements between the parties, and subsequent discussion, agreements and understandings, whether verbal or in writing are subsumed under this agreement.
2. This agreement is not considered to be a contract creating legal and financial obligations between FSA TUI and BCSW. This agreement is designed to facilitate genuine and mutually beneficial study programs, research relationships, and exchange programs.

3. It is agreed that FSA TU and BCSW will work together to promote the following:
 - a. Exchange of publications, information, and other educational and research materials;
 - b. Collaboration of faculty and research scholars;
 - c. Cooperation in the implementation of student internship, study abroad and exchange programs;
 - d. Joint research in the field of social work;
 - e. Professional meetings for education and research;
 - f. Faculty exchange;
 - g. Student exchange;
 - h. Staff and faculty development; and
 - i. Program exchanges for the advancement of social work
4. This agreement is incorporated into, and will provide the foundation and framework for the particular projects developed by academic and administrative units from the two institutions and embodied in the implemented agreements.
5. This agreement, when executed by the parties, shall become effective on September 30, 2014 and shall continue for a period of five (5) years ending September 30, 2019.
6. This agreement may be renewed for a period by mutual consent of the parties, renewals shall be in writing and subject to the same terms and conditions set forth herein. Resources for implementation of this agreement may come from either party, depending upon budgetary availability, neither party is obligated to expend any resources in connection with this agreement. No implementation of any portion of this agreement or commencement of any specific projects may be initiated prior to the written assurance of adequate budgetary resources.
7. This agreement shall not be construed to create a relationship of partners, brokers, employees, servants' joint ventures or agents as between the parties. The parties to this agreement are acting as independent participants, with respect to employee compensation for services provided in connection with the agreement, each party shall be responsible for its own employees' withholding taxes, workers' compensation and other employment-related taxes.
8. This agreement shall be governed and construed under the laws of the Thailand with respect to FSA TU and the laws of the Republic of Indonesia with respect to BCSW. The parties shall cooperate mutually to resolve any dispute or misunderstanding by collaboration and discussion.
9. Either party shall have the absolute right to terminate this agreement with or without cause upon sixty (60) days prior written notice to the other party. Such termination shall not become effective as to students already enrolled and participating in a program at the host institution.


In witness whereof, the parties hereto hereby sign this Memorandum of Understanding on the date above-mentioned.


